Instructions for Equine nutrient analysis testing via mane hair

Items needed:

- **1)** Small <u>stainless steel</u> scissors: Manicure scissors work too, available at any drug store.
- 2) One envelope for each hair sample (white no padding)
- **3)** A teaspoon (or a good mental impression about the amount of hair filling a teaspoon)
- **4)** Client forms (please enclose them in the mail along with the hair sample)

Taking the mane hair sample:

We need the mane hair which grew out recently. This is the hair closest to the body. Cut the hair closest to the skin along the crest from a few different areas. Avoid forelock and wither area. Then cut the older tips off and discard them so that the length of the test hair remains about half an inch long.

Use a separate white paper envelope for each hair sample (please no aluminum or plastic wrap)

Enclose the client forms. Send hair and forms to the address provided in your order confirmation. If you did not see an order confirmation in your email inbox, please send us an email to the address below.

From the time we receive the sample from you, it takes roughly two weeks for the results to come in.
